1. Welcome, thank you. Apologies: Barbara, Betty, Clare H, Ester, Hsin-Liang, Immy, Ingrid, Keith, Lois, Macu, maybe Jennie B.

- 2. Minutes from the last meeting 13 March 2022 (on website): to agree. Any changes needed?
- 3. **The last AGM was delayed to September 2021**. This report is for the full financial year from May 2021–30 April 2022 with a status report for other activities.
- 4. **Elections**: we try to keep things informal but also need to be 'governed well'.
 - a. Happy to stand again: Rebecca Jones (Secretary); Julian Hickling (Treasurer); Jennie Brandon, Bob Billingham (Co-chairs).
 Standing down: Keith as Membership Secretary; Lois as Co-chair.
 - b. **New nominee**: Julia Leong (co-chair). We don't need a membership secretary. Do we want/need a more formal committee?
- 5. Annual financial review 1 May 2021–30 April 2022: Brief Treasurer's report from Julian (accounts circulated by e-mail and on website). In brief: Gardeners' current account (on 30 April 2022) had: £1,095.89.
 - a. **Balance from allocated grants**: £371.18 remaining; about £188.98 unspent as part of Kindness grant but should be spent soon (agreed with Grants); £182.20 unspent as part of polytunnel grant (can use for fitting out if/when we decided to use it more for plants and less for seating); Garden kitchen grant will be managed by Council (there is £300 owed to us for pizza oven Julian needs to claim this).
 - b. **Balance from Friends memberships and donations (unallocated): £724.71**; we spent some funds on Learn and Grow (~£25.00); £370.41 on playhouse; £332.00 on the larch for the bench; £188.63 on insurance. The balance is enough for insurance in September 2022 and expenses. We have not pursued business sponsorship yet but have had one recent offer.
- 6. **Non-gardening volunteering including working with local families**. Discussion to be led by Julia Leong, Rebecca (with David Lynch). Includes Little Nightingales... Learn and Grow... Gate opening... wellbeing-related events. How to encourage more of this without increasing workload? How to involve people volunteering in the constituted group and Friends group?
- 7. **Status report for 8 May 2022**: for information only:
 - a. Membership. On our formal membership list we have six officers; ~18 regular gardeners; ~18 people who garden infrequently but volunteer in other ways (and/or want to stay on the weekly e-mail list).
 - b. Friends: 56 on Friends list. Most have made donations of various sizes and frequency (one every month); some are former/infrequent volunteers and want to have less frequent emails. Haven't been very actively recruiting recently.
 - c. **Friends newsletter**: currently working on the sixth issue (June–August 2022); two more planned for 2022 and then we might move to one every three months.
 - d. Time credits. 21 people have signed up for digital time credits. Aim to review this...
 - e. 'Volunteering.
 - i. For gardening, currently, we are running short sessions up to twice a week in small groups with volunteers 'booking' to say they are coming; Sundays and Mondays 2 pm to 4 pm. Rebecca has frequent contacts via e-mail or in person from people interested in gardening. Also a few from corporate groups. We could have longer sessions when toilets are available again (no knowledge of when this will be yet).
 - ii. Gate opening: have three sets of people doing it (1 day, 2 days and 4 days).

- f. **Events**: this year has been very busy with some events linked to Kindness grant. Good attendance (Learn and Grow; St Martin's Day 11 Nov 2021; pre-Xmas New year and Easter get togethers) to very high attendance (Moon festival Sept 2021; Chinese New Year Feb 2022). Events will be easier when have kitchen, power and toilet access.

 - xii. Little Nightingales;
 - xiii. Mindfulness in Nature at Nightingale (7 May) maybe more of them?
